<u>In-line hockey</u> is one of the more popular areas in camp. In order to participate, <u>campers must at a minimum come equipped with</u>: **Roller blades, elbow & kneepads, gloves or wrist protectors.** Helmets (without cages or facemasks) & sticks are provided at camp. Campers may choose to bring their own sticks and helmets as well.
